Optional items, but not necessary:

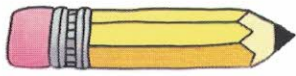
1. *Colored pencils or crayons*

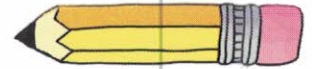
