

EUREKA COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
USE AND POSSESSION OF CELL PHONES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC
DEVICES BY STUDENTS

Pursuant to NRS 392.4637, students may possess electronic devices, including but not limited to cellphones, iPads, iPods, tablets, etc., provided that such devices do not disrupt the educational program or school activity. Any disruptive, inappropriate, or illegal usage of any electronic devices will result in disciplinary consequences.

At the high school level, electronic devices shall be turned off during class time and during any segment of the school day when assessment is being administered, or at the absolute discretion of the School Administration.

At the middle and elementary school levels, electronic signaling devices shall be turned off during the regular school day. The site administrator will identify the appropriate time to use electronic devices during the school day or in conjunction with extra-curricular activities.

In the event a student violates the provisions of this policy, the following progressive discipline steps will be administered as appropriate:

First Offense: Warning and confiscation of the device for the day.

Second Offense: The device is confiscated, and a parent must meet with school officials to claim the phone/device.

Additional Offenses: Repeated violations will result in further disciplinary action(s).
