

EUREKA COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
TRANSPORTATION ROUTES AND REGULATIONS

NRS 392.300 permits a school district, at its complete discretion, to furnish transportation to resident pupils who reside at such a distance from school as to make transportation necessary and desirable.

Bus routes are at the discretion of the Board of Trustees, upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools. The established routes may be extended if the if the Board determines that it is economically feasible.

Established routes are those routes run along main highways when there are a sufficient numbers of children to justify those routes to the established points. They will ordinarily remain constant for the school year. (If the route must be cut back because of lack of students, the route will still be maintained to the point at which there are significant children boarding to make the route to that point economically feasible.)
