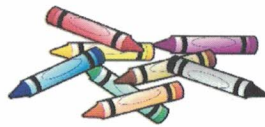

\*Extra supplies that are used a lot and always appreciated in our classroom:

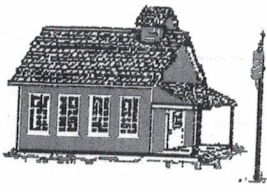
-Tissues      -Clorox wipes      -Glue sticks

### **Optional for individual student:**

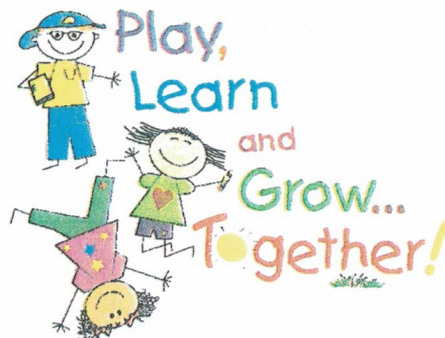
- \*art supply list that Abby Sweet sent out

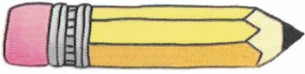

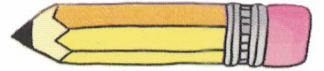
