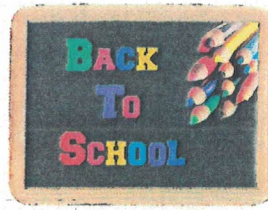

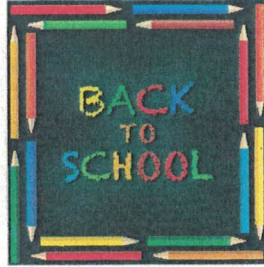

*Crayons and colored pencils should be the smaller box. (16 for crayons and 12 for colored pencils work great.) We do not have room in our desks for the large box. Extra highlighters, markers, and glue sticks will go into a shared drawer for use throughout the school year, no need to label them with your student's name.

*I encourage my students to have their own water bottle to keep at school. They should have an easy open/close lid and their name on it.

*Extra supplies that are used a lot and always appreciated in our classroom:

-Tissues -Clorox wipes -Glue sticks

*I will supply all paper, folders, and notebooks; no need to send notebooks or binders.

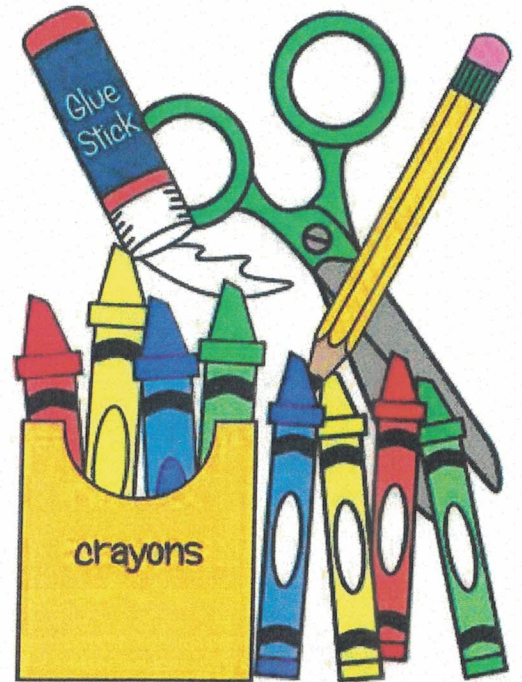

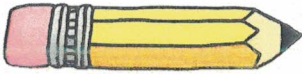
Extra supplies that are greatly appreciated

- Disinfectant wipes

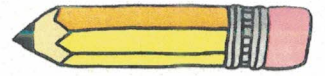
We will have headphones for the students to use, but your child is welcome to bring in their own if they would prefer.
